Installation Notes

- a) Bollard must be installed 1500mm deep into the parking space measured from the front starting line of the carspace, and an even distance from the two side boundary lines of the space.
- b) Bollard must be located within the designated car space and ensure it will not cause any obstruction to adjacent vehicles when they enter or leave the neighbouring parking spaces.
- c) Bollards must be installed after receiving approval from the Owners Corporation / Building Manager.
- d) Only three holes to be drilled on the carpark surface (Use only 10mm bolts supplied with bollard). Use flat washers first then place the mounting nuts over the bolt studs and install bollard unit to the ground.
- e) Refer installation guide supplied along with parking bollard for accurate hole drilling measurements on carpark surface.
- f) All damage to common property must be repaired at the expense of the lot owner and the surface of the car park slab must be patched and repaired when the car park bollard is removed.
